The College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) exam is an opportunity for students to demonstrate knowledge and possibly earn college credit. When students register for a CLEP exam, they will have the option to submit their exam score to Madison College for evaluation. Once Madison College receives the official score report, credit will be awarded for tests that meet the minimum score required.

The awarding of CLEP credit varies by institution. If you intend to transfer to another college or university after Madison College, make sure to check with that institution regarding their CLEP policies.
