Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Appeal

Instructions

U.S. federal regulations for financial aid and veteran education benefits require anyone receiving these benefits to meet certain academic standards. At Madison College, these academic standards are referred to as Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP). These standards include a cumulative 2.0 GPA, a cumulative completion rate of 67%, and program completion within 150% of the credits required to graduate (Maximum Attempted Credits). SAP is evaluated at the end of each term and is calculated using all credits attempted. If you fail to meet SAP standards, you are no longer eligible for financial aid and veterans education benefits (if applicable). All ineligible students receive a message outlining which standards were not met.

<u>OPTION 1:</u> If there were circumstances outside of your control that caused your suspension, you have the option to appeal by submitting the following documents:

- 1. The SAP Appeal form
- 2. Supporting documentation based on a qualifying reason (see examples listed on page 2)

Please note, failure to submit supporting documentation will delay the review of your appeal.

Examples

- You had a medical emergency and had to withdraw from all of your classes. You would complete and submit the SAP Appeal form, and submit the SAP Medical Documentation form for review.
- You previously completed a program at Madison College. You were then suspended for exceeding the Maximum
 Attempted Credits in your current program. You would explain on the SAP Appeal form that you previously
 completed a program, how you plan to complete your current program in a timely manner, and indicate that the
 documentation is on file.

<u>OPTION 2:</u> If there were not circumstances outside of your control that caused your suspension, you have the option to appeal <u>after</u> you have shown Academic Improvement:

To appeal with a reason of Academic Improvement, you must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Pay for and complete at least six (6) credits in one semester at Madison College
- 2. Complete all classses with no drops on or after the course start dates;
- 3. Have no final grades of W, WNA, U, F, NCR and I;
- 4. Achieve a 2.0 term GPA; AND
- 5. Submit the SAP Appeal form after requirements are met.

Example

• Your first semester grades were not good because you didn't spend enough time on your homework. This is not a situation that is outside of your control. You may appeal after you have shown Academic Improvement. Once the requirements are met, you would submit the appeal form, and your successful grades will serve as documentation.

On the SAP Appeal Form, you will be asked to provide an explanation of the circumstances surrounding your suspension, and how the situation has changed and you are now able to return to school. The supporting documentation you submit must support your reason for appeal. Multiple pieces of documentation may be required to provide a complete picture of the situation.

Madison College Authorized Signature

All students appealing a financial aid and veterans education benefit (if applicable) suspension are required to meet with a Madison College Academic Advisor, Counselor or Student Success Coach, prior to submitting their appeal. Academic Plan

If your appeal is granted, you will be placed on an Academic Plan status. The Academic Plan requirements are listed below. To stay financial aid and veterans education benefit (if applicable) eligible, you must meet the Academic Plan requirements each term until you meet all of the Satisfactory Academic Plan requirements, or complete your program. If you fail to meet the Academic Plan requirements, you will be placed back on suspension and will not be eligible for financial aid and veteran education benefits (if applicable).

- 1. Complete all classes with no drops on or after the course start dates;
- 2. Have no final grades of W, WNA, U, F, NCR and I; AND
- 3. Achieve at least a 2.0 term GPA.
